Curriculum at a Glance: IXL, Notgrass, Apologia, Memoria Press, BJU, Abeka

Frequently Asked Questions:

- **LMS:** Canvas is our Learning Management System (assignments, grades, communication)
- **Class Delivery:** Asynchronous (pre-recorded videos instead of scheduled video calls)
- **Curriculum:** Parents are responsible for purchasing curriculum with the exception of IXL

Fee Schedule:

Deposit (non-refundable): \$250 (deposit applied to balance; secures student's schedule)

Tuition: \$500/class for full-year classes, \$250/class for one-semester classes

Late Fees: Late Registration Fee (\$100 after July 15th); Late Payment Fee (\$30)

Early Bird Discount: 15% discount on total bill when entire balance is paid by February 28, 2026

Payment Options: 1) pay tuition in full on or before August 10th (cash, check, Venmo)

- 2) two semester payments (two post-dated checks dated Aug. 10, Dec. 11)
- 3) ten monthly payments (10 post-dated checks for the 1st of each month, Aug.-May; plus a one-time \$50 service fee)

School Calendar 2026-2027:

August 10: first day of classes

September 7: last day to drop a class for partial refund
